

GREAT WHITE ENTERS TOP 10 CLASSIC ROCK RADIO CHART

Multi-platinum recording artists, GREAT WHITE announced today that the band's third single off of *Elation*, "Hard to Say Goodbye," has reached No. 10 on the classic rock radio Mediabase chart. The heartfelt single has tugged the heartstrings of audiences, especially the military.

GREAT WHITE released *Elation* (the band's 12th studio record) from Frontiers Records in May 2012. *Elation* thrives on GREAT WHITE's signature grit and blues-hued sound, only marked with a new synergy.
